The winner gets the bragging rights for a few months. The bummer part of it is there are way too many commercials, most of which promote things that really do not need any extra attention. (Can you tell I have a bias?) To be sure some will make us laugh. Guess what the cost of a 30 second add is for this super bowl? 2.6 million. This is BIG business!

Let me say just a word about an even bigger event going on—it is the battle taking place between God and Satan. This is quite different from football games where either team can potentially win.
