In thinking about Romans 12:3-8 in preparation for the sermon this morning some things struck me about how independent we (I) have become. Yet the call of Christianity draws us together to work as a body and function as a body. Our independence can keep distance between us and hinder work and growth.

It is not good when a husband and wife's practice is to function with total independence. Oneness is not achieved that way.

The same is true in our relationship to the body of Christ. If we isolate ourselves and function independently we are not being drawn together. I like the word that was kind of a buzz word in certain circles for a while – that's synergy. Broadly defined it is "combined action or operation" (Webster), but Stephen Covey in his book, Seven Habits of Highly Effective People says synergy is "when the whole is greater than the sum of the parts." In other words, when we work together we can accomplish more than when we work independently. He is further quoted as saying, "Many people have not really experienced even a moderate degree of synergy in their family life or in other interactions. They've been trained and scripted into defensive and protective communications or into believing that life and other people can't be trusted. This represents one of the great tragedies and wastes in life, because so much potential remains untapped - completely undeveloped and unused. Ineffective people live day after day with unused potential. They experience synergy only in small, peripheral ways in their lives."

BINGO! It is that independent spirit which keeps us distant and hinders the greater good that could be done. We need to be connected to the body, pooling our resources of time, talent, and money.

Certainly there are times we need to find our quiet place for prayer as Jesus did. If you allow me a little latitude for interpretation, by Jesus' example we need time for relaxing – not being a part of the crowd. But, to a great degree we have taken this too far to where our personal time and space is more important than our body time. No, as a member of the body I am counted on to do my part. When the body points me in a direction my response as a member is, "certainly." The independent spirit say, "no, I don't want to do that."

I am challenged by this passage in Romans 12. I hope you will be too. Then, together we synergize!
