## Chapin's Corner

This is a time of year for dreams. Many dream of having the independence they desire. Others have big dreams of making a difference in the world. Still others will dream of having success in the workplace by making their fortune. Rich or poor is not the issue. (Some might add, unless you're poor.) Fame or obscurity is also not the issue. When it comes to evaluating our lives, the ONLY thing that really matters is whether or not we have a relationship with the Lord Jesus. If he is not our Lord, all other pursuits wind up being an exercise in futility. A long time ago Solomon talked about such things. He sought for the meaning of life in much the same way people do today.

Education. I believe in education, but if that is all we have, we will be snobs. As Solomon really set out to find wisdom, he concluded that is not the real meaning of life (Ecclesiastes 1:17).

Pleasure. Our world is crazy with seeking after pleasure. Certainly there is some satisfaction in fulfilling desires, but if that is our idea of what life is all about, then we will be unfulfilled. Solomon had no lack of opportunity for pleasure, yet he says, "but that also proved to be meaningless," Ecclesiastes 2:1.

Being Busy. There's another modern trap. We get so busy with busy work that we lose sight of why we are busy. Solomon found out that was not the meaning of life, Ecclesiastes 2:11.

On and on we could go with Solomon's lessons. As he wraps up Ecclesiastes he gives his conclusion about what really is important – what the real meaning of life is. He says, Now all has been heard; here is the conclusion of the matter: Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the whole duty of man. <sup>14</sup>For God will bring every deed into judgment, including every hidden thing, whether it is good or evil. (Ecclesiastes 12:13-14, NIV)

May our graduates pursue God with all their hearts. That is the greatest dream of all. Then they will find peace and contentment in their lives ahead—they will find the true meaning of life.
