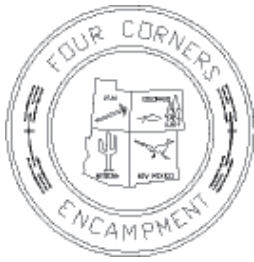

Independence Day is right here. It is a great time of celebration for our nation's beginning. We are the recipients of a great nation because of the sacrifice our fore fathers were willing to make so that there could be freedom. Pray for our nation. Pray that our leaders will recapture the spirit of freedom and work to maintain that blessing.

On our individual level, this is a good time to reflect on ways that Satan wants to bind us and declare independence from his attempt to control. A good friend of mine talks about his independence from the bottle. His wife planted the idea that Independence Day was a good time to be really free. He accepted the challenge and has remained free for many years.

Satan is not one to sit back and watch. He will attack our thinking, trying to get us to justify our behavior. "There's nothing wrong with . . . (you finish the statement)."

Many things indeed can be good when used appropriately. But with a lot of things, problems arise when a person seems driven to it. For example, drugs can be used in a medicinal way and provide benefits. But it can be poison to the system if over used. It becomes Satan's tool when we become dependent on the cure.

Here is what Paul says: **1 Corinthians 6:12** ¹²"Everything is permissible for me"—but not everything is beneficial. "Everything is permissible for me"—but I will not be mastered by anything. (NIV) Satan wants to take that first part and ignore the last. Legalists want to take the last and ignore the first. The balance is what we really need to see. The question is not so much "can I do this" as it is, "who is in control." If we are honest, much of what we justify is in the name of our passion (insert the word addiction here). If that is what is driving us, we need independence. Being "transformed by the renewing of our mind," Romans 12:2, is the way to be truly independent.
