What's going on with me diagnosis wise? I guess you are now aware that the diagnosis has changed from leukemia to mantle cell lymphoma. I have yet another blood draw tomorrow to do some specific testing with this change in mind. That kind of threw me at first as the Dr. said this is harder to treat than the leukemia, but he did talk of how this can be put into remission. Our family Dr. has been in contact with the oncologist and found out that he will be wanting to do a biopsy and maybe a bone marrow test. That will be good because Tobi and Traci contacted M.D. Anderson to see what it would take to go to Houston to get a second opinion. They said they need a definitive diagnosis from a biopsy before they will talk to me.

That's a long way of saying that we still do not have a definite diagnosis. In the mean time I still solicit your prayers as it is God who has the real diagnosis and the best solution. I can tell you this much, this has given me a renewed sense of urgency in praying for all who are on our prayer concerns. We have numerous people going through tough times that need the comfort of the Lord. Join me in a renewed commitment to prayer for all of them.
