3. **Your ability to use the Bible.** The successful Christian witness has to know his Bible. With a thorough knowledge of God's Word, you should be able to answer the questions and excuses put forward by the unsaved.
4. **Your willingness to try.** You can't win others to Christ if you don't make the effort! Catch the vision.
